Generally, costs range from about \$132.00 to \$275.00 depending on what is required. More detailed fee information: https://notarynsw.org.au/recommended-fees/
The things that add to the cost include:-

- + More pages, where there is more than just a single document.
- + More certificates, where more than one notarial certificate has to be prepared & attached to documents.
- + More people, if there are more than one person who must be identified & signatures must be witnessed.
- + Companies, if companies are involved.
- + Apostilles, legalisation certificates must be obtained from the Department of Foreign Affairs & Trade (DFAT).
- + Authentication certificates, must be obtained from an embassy or consulate.
